Wood Trellis Posts Quality Does Matter!

Today with climbing material and labor costs it's critical that you get the most value for your dollar.

When it comes to your trellis needs, make sure you are getting a quality product. At **OVS** we exclusively supply CCA-treated posts from **Princeton Wood Preservers**. It all starts with quality wood. Princeton only uses Lodgepole Pine, a renewable resource grown specifically and logged for Princeton. Before treatment, posts are kiln dried for optimum penetration of preservative and longevity. This also prevents any moisture getting trapped in the interior of the wood, allowing for core decay. The posts are pressure treated to .6 lbs/cubic ft. The post then move back to the kiln for fixation. This extra step ensures that the post fully retains treatment and minimizes the possibility of any leaching of chemicals into the soil.



Recently OVS was invited out to inspect Princeton Wood Preservers posts that had been removed from a vineyard in Dundee, Oregon. The site was being readied for replanting. The original development of the site started in 1982 and continued through 1989. The posts were in amazing shape. Other than the staining from the Red Hills soil they were in, there was almost no sign of deterioration.



An entire local vineyard trellis system was decimated by an infestation of wood boring insects. Damage that could have been prevented with properly treated posts.
